THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 3 (PART) PARISH OF MAIDS MORETON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by Buckinghamshire Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Buckinghamshire Council Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate in the Parish of Maids Moreton and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 8 days from the date of confirmation of this Order, or on the date on which Buckinghamshire Council certify that the works to bring the new site of the footpath, described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out to their reasonable satisfaction, whichever is the later, and thereupon the Buckinghamshire Council Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.

- 2. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in paragraph 1 above shall have the following rights over the land referred to, namely: they shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the extinguishment took place.
- 3. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate in the Parish of Maids Moreton described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Buckinghamshire Council Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- 3A. The Buckinghamshire Council Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.


