

## Clearance for Tree Planting – MM Playing Fields



### Notes

Point	Notes
1	20m by 10m, bramble and blackthorn scrub plus soil dump. Brambles to be grubbed out, excessive blackthorn removed leaving some larger stems. Soil dump to be spread out over cleared area. To be planted by volunteers with 5 or 7 each of birch and rowan in a diamond shape to complement existing groups and grass to be mown creating open sitting area adjacent to play park.
2	Brambles to be grubbed out within group of oak and ash, no planting, mown grass.
3	37m strip outside cricket field. To be planted with 5 or 7 each birch and rowan in diamond shapes. No clearance work required; clean site can be prepared entirely by volunteers. May include dogwood patch in SE corner if sufficient plants are available.
4	14m by 16m, heavily overgrown bramble scrub to be grubbed out. Diamond of 5 oak to be planted by volunteers and grass mown to create sitting area adjacent to pavilion.
5	Hedge to be established, about 17m long with hawthorn, hazel and possibly blackthorn planted by volunteers. No clearance work required; clean site can be prepared entirely by volunteers.
6	Moderate bramble growth to be grubbed out, 1 oak and 2 birch planted in a triangle, then mown
7	Three heavy bramble patches, each 10-12m long alongside tarmac to be grubbed out back to ditch. To be planted with (a) 3 oak, (b) 5 hazel, (c) 3 each crab apple and dogwood. Trees to be set back, grass in front mown for dog exercise adjacent to tarmac as it is closer to the Scout Hut.
